

## Faculty Classroom Cell Phone Policy

RAVE is the primary method of communication used by Samford University during a campus emergency\*. In many classrooms, the only RAVE-activated devices are faculty and student cell phones, yet faculty generally require that all student phones be turned off during class and test taking. Faculty must have a hard copy of their class roll and must take their cell phone to every class and periodically monitor it for any emergency RAVE message. If a faculty member does not have a cell phone or does not bring their cell phone to class, they must give permission to a student to monitor their phone for possible emergencies.
